

Civil society on fact-finding mission

Bengaluru: Various civil society organisations of the city have come together to conduct fact-finding into the violence at DJ Halli. Civil society members urged people to come forward with information. The 24-member fact-finding team will develop a timeline of events that led to the violent outbreak on August 11 at DJ Halli and surrounding areas, and is expected to publish a report in 10 days.
